3. **ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM**

LIONS (Kindergarten), TIGERS, WOLFS, BEARS, WEBELOS I AND ARROW OF LIGHT

LIONS will wear a special T-Shirt as their uniform and will only meet a couple of times a month however; they will participate in Pack Meeting with all of our other Cub Scouts. They can start wearing the blue uniform in the first grade. Lions and Tigers will meet on alternate weeks. Once your son or daughter is signed up and *registered with Scouting America*, you can go to ***Scouting.org/resources/scout book*** and sign up to use ***SCOUTBOOK*** to track your child's advancement.

4. **POPCORN SALES CAMPAIGN**

In your packet is a Popcorn Sales Order Sheet. This is our **only** fundraiser we do each year primary source of income during the year. This helps pay for the advancement the scouts earn during the year and represents more than 80% of our annual budget. We hope that everyone will participate. Key dates: Order Turn-In (**Oct 19th**), Popcorn Pickup (**Nov 12th**), Money Turn-In (**Dec 7st**) Scouts will have an opportunity to sell door to door as well as participate in our Storefront opportunities.

4. **FIRST MEETING** (September 14th) at 6:00 p.m. We will be meeting in the Parking Lot, at Second Presbyterian Church for a Den Organization Meeting and the scouts will have a chance to participate in our Water Rockets event. No uniforms are required however everyone is requested to bring an empty two-liter soda

bottle and a towel. Parents will be able to order **Pack T-shirts**. Our first den meetings will take place on Monday, Sept. 21st at 6:00 p.m.

5. Uniforms

Lions will wear a special T-shirt as their uniform. Tigers will wear the traditional Blue Cub Scout Uniform with the orange neckerchief and this uniform, with the appropriate neckerchief and be worn through the 4th grade (Webelos 1). Normally the cub scouts will switch to the Khaki Shirt and Green Pants in the 5th grade year. They will keep this same uniform as they transition into Boy Scouting.
